

### Homily Hints

#### The Big Question:

“In what ways can I help to change the world?”

#### Chapter Goals:

1. to understand that the virtues of faith, hope, and love unite us to God
2. to love, to hope, and to have faith as we follow Jesus Christ together as the Church
3. to live in a way that proclaims the marks of the Church: one, holy, catholic, and apostolic.

#### Homily Hints:

Begin your homily with a discussion of habits. Part of the human condition is to develop ways of doing things or ways of reacting to things. Talk about good and bad habits people develop.

As Christians, we have been given a wonderful gift: the virtues of faith, hope, and love, which all have God as their source, motive, and object. We can see these virtues as good habits that lead us as disciples and members of the Church.

As members of the church we also live out the marks of the Church. These also give us strength to reach out and offer the love and ministry of Jesus Christ to others.

Young people are receptive to the idea that their generation will help to change the world. This conversation can be a wonderful way to start young people understanding that, as followers of Jesus Christ, they have a mission to help change the world.
