#### Helpful Tips

Build Vocabulary and Access Home Language Use a translation app or device to share with children how to say the names of animal homes and habitats in their home language that they might not be able to identify as you read animal books throughout the unit. For example: air, Spanish=aire; water, Spanish=aqua; land, Spanish=tierra; desert, Spanish=desierta; ocean, Spanish=océano: forest. Spanish=bosaue.

Sound Transfer The focus letters in Unit 3 are Dd. Ee. and Ff.

- Dd The /d/ sound and spelling transfer in Spanish, Vietnamese, and Hmong. Model correct mouth position (lips separated). Guide children to place the tongue behind the upper front teeth and feel their jaw drop as they say
- Ee The /e/ sound has an approximate transfer in Vietnamese, Cantonese, Mandarin, Farsi, and Arabic. Model correct mouth position (lips unrounded). Guide children to place the front of the tongue mid-height in the mouth to produce the sound.
- Ff The /f/ sound and spelling transfer in Spanish and Hmong. Model correct mouth position (top teeth sitting on lower lip). Guide children to feel the breath escaping as they pronounce the sound.

Parent and Family Partnerships Send home the Unit 3 multilingual Family Letters in the Knowledge Building Student Activity Pad. The letters inform families of key learning goals and provides activities to extend classroom learning.

# Additional

#### Learners with Special Needs

Throughout the lessons in Unit 3, use the following modifications to support children with special needs. For an extensive list of modifications, go to SadlierConnect.com

#### Language Delays, Cognitive Delays, and Children on the Autism Spectrum

- Some children might struggle learning songs at the normal speed. Sing the song slowly when you introduce it, before using the audio recording.
- ✓ Add Velcro dots to puzzles to stabilize small pieces. Place a hard Velcro dot on the puzzle base and a soft Velcro dot on the puzzle piece. This will help the pieces stay in place when the child is working.
- Use tape to attach a single piece of paper to the table, or a large sheet of paper on the table. The tape will help stabilize the paper so that it does not move ground when children need to work.
- Some children may repeatedly perform the same play actions, such as playing in the sand or scribbling. To help children find variety in play, model other ways of playing with the materials, and ask the child to copy you.
- Model how to ask another child to pass materials. Encourage children to use full sentences and names. For example, to a child who says, "glue," say, "If you would like the glue, tell Juan, 'Juan, please pass the glue."

#### Physical, Visual, and Speech and Language Impairments

- Use a black marker and ruler to simplify cutting activities. Draw straight lines between or around pictures.
- In sorting activities, place the pictures or objects on high-contrast yellow or black sheets of laminated paper.
- Use foam sheets to help children grasp the handles of fine motor instruments such as pencils, crayons, paintbrushes, and spoons. Wrap the foam sheet around the instrument, and secure with duct or painters tape.
- If a child makes a grammatical error or mispronounces a word, repeat the sentence using the correct grammar and pronunciation. For example, if a child says, "I gived you my book," you might reply, "Thank you. It's nice that you gave me your book."
- ✓ Use technology such as e-Books to benefit children with physical disabilities as they can turn the pages without struggling. Audio books allow children with visual disabilities to access books and can provide pronunciation for children with speech impairments.



# Support

#### Behavior Problems, Attention Deficit Disorder, and ADHD

- State what is not acceptable behavior, such as pushing or falling on someone, before doing a physical activity. Offer frequent praise and positive reinforcement.
- ✓ Using colored tape as visual supports for the environment. Place a strip on the floor where children line up. Use tape arrows to show proper movement pathways and tape lines to define clear borders between centers and activity areas.
- ✓ Create a turn-taking prop, or a visual reminder of whose turn it is. Use glue to attach a craft stick to a foam sheet. During a turn-taking activity the child who is holding the prop takes his/her turn while the others wait.
- ☑ Use verbal and visual cues to help children anticipate transitions. Ten minutes before the end of an activity, announce "ten minutes left" while holding up ten fingers. Then follow with five-minute and two-minute warnings.
- ✓ Use positive language to remind children of classroom rules and to set clear expectations. For example, rather than saying "Don't throw your coat on the floor," say: "The rule is, children must hang up their coats. Here's your hook."

#### **General Tips**

- Articulation Many children are still developing their ability to form sounds up to the age of 7. Continue to reinforce proper articulation, acknowledging and appreciating children's regional dialects, accents, and sound development.
- Student Engagement Use nonverbal cues to engage all children, especially nonverbal children. For example, reinforce that we use "quiet hands" when we want to share something to the class. After a child responds, teach hand signals for agree (e.g., thumbs up), disagree (shake finger), and add on (the ASL signal for "more"). Children respond to other classmates' responses using these nonverbal signals, which also alert the teacher to auestions and understandings/ misunderstandings.
